UK Study Guide 2023

The UK Government provides an opportunity for all Indian students to study in the country but as a prerequisite, you'll have to obtain a student visa first. The visa you need will depend on your age and the type of study you wish to pursue in the UK.

You can apply for a student visa six months before the start of your course at the earliest and you'll receive the decision on your application within three working weeks considering normal circumstances.

We recommend you plan your arrival depending upon the duration of the course because If your course is for six months or less, then you can arrive in the UK up to 1 week before, but if your course is for more than six months, then you can arrive in the UK up to 1 month before.

To be eligible for a student visa, you must:

- Have an unconditional offer of a place on a course with a licensed sponsor/ Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) reference number and documents used to obtain CAS
- Valid English-language proficiency score
- Financial proof i.e., exhibiting enough money to support yourself and pay for your course

Here's an overview of the types of study visas and their application requirements:

Student Visa	place in a course at a UK	start of your	Up to one week before if your course lasts six months or fewer. Up to one month before if your course lasts more than six months

To be eligible for a student visa, you must:

- Have confirmation acceptance of studies from a valid UK institution
- Acceptable English Language proficiency test scores such as IELTS
- Financial proof i.e., exhibiting enough money to support yourself and pay for your course. You would need approx. £1,334 per month (for up to 9 months) for courses in London and £1,023 per month (for up to 9 months) for courses outside London (also known as maintenance funds)

Documents required for student visa

When applying for your visa, you will generally need:

- A current passport or other valid travel documentation
- Evidence of funds to provide your living expenses for the duration of your course
- Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) reference number and documents used to obtain CAS
- Passport-sized color photographs
- Tuberculosis screening (mandatory for South Asian countries)
- Assessment documentation
- Academic Technology Approval Scheme (ATAS) clearance certificate (if required)

Additional documents may also be needed if you are:

- Not a citizen of the country you are applying from
- Under 18 years of age
- Have family (dependents)

If any of your supporting documents are not in English, you will need to have them translated. Each translated document must be dated, and include the translator's name and signature and confirmation that it is an accurate translation of the original document.

Applying for your visa online

You'll have to apply for your student visa application online using the British Government's official <u>Gov.UK website</u>. You can apply up to 6 months before your intended date of travel to the UK. Remember, your application date is the date when your application fee is paid.

Visa fee

The Visa fee depends upon the visa that you will apply for:

Visa	Visa fee
Student visa	It costs £363 as the application fee for the visa from outside the UK. Also, you need to pay £490 to extend or switch student visas from inside the UK.*

Mode of payment

- Online mode i.e., MasterCard or Visa card
- Through demand draft to be submitted at the visa application center or the selected branches of Standard Chartered Bank
- Through cash payment at the visa application center or the selected branches of Standard Chartered Bank

English language requirements

Generally, universities in the UK require a minimum score of **50-57** in PTE ACADEMIC however, pathway and foundation courses also accept 42-49 PTE ACADEMIC overall. Some institutions in the UK also offer waivers considering students' scores in English in the 12th standard. For the PG Degree course, it has to be a 58-63 score in PTE Academic

Biometric residence permit

As part of your application, you must also obtain a biometric residence permit (BRP) from the UKVI. You will need to make an appointment with the UKVI for having your fingerprints scanned, and a digital photo taken of your face.

Tips for your UK visa

- 1. Try not to postpone your visa appointment until the last minute as it takes at least 3 working weeks to receive a student visa.
- 2. Start your visa process six months in advance.
- 3. You must have the certificate of acceptance for studies (CAS) from your university before the visa application process.
- 4. Check if the institute is licensed before applying for it.
